What is the camping situation, what are we expected to bring?

Cub Scouts and their families will be given the option to camp with their connected troop or in our platform campsites. Packs looking to camp with a troop can email us at CampDirector@psrweb.org and let us know. Packs without a connected Troop will be assigned a default campsite. Campsites will have platform tents, cots and mattress, running water and a pit latrine in the site. Those staying with a troop must bring their own tents and will be camping in the field. Lunch on Saturday and Breakfast on Sunday will be provided with the cost of the event. All other meals must be provided by the family or Pack. Do I have to stay the full weekend?
