

EXTREME SPORTS DIRECTOR



General: Oversee the Extreme Sports Area, insuring safety and quality of instruction.

Responsible to: Program Director

Specifics:

1. Oversee the Extreme Sports program. Ensure positive training for Scouts and adult leaders in the proper methods of climbing, and safety rules are taught.
2. Be at least 18 years of age
3. Have background in Mountain Biking and/or Mountain Boarding
4. Insure that the Extreme Sports area meets established standards. Proper BSA standards for instruction, supervision and safety training are carried out.
5. Serve as a merit badge counselor for Extreme Sports Merit Badges.
6. Conduct a weekly Mountain Biking outpost.
7. Serve as a C.I.T. Mentor.
8. Be an enthusiastic key leader of the entire camp staff – work closely with the Camp Director and other key leaders in providing positive leadership to the staff. Assist the Program Director in planning and implementing staff morale boosters.
9. Attend Area Directors meetings.
10. Responsible for opening and closing inventories of all Extreme Sports equipment.
11. Other duties as assigned by the Camp Director.
