

TOWER DIRECTOR



General: Oversee the Climbing Tower, ensuring safety and quality of instruction.

Responsible to: Program Director

Specifics:

1. Oversee the Tower program. Ensure positive training for Scouts and adult leaders in the proper methods of climbing, and safety rules are taught.
2. Be at least 21 years of age
3. Be Trained on running the Tower.
4. Ensure that the Climbing Tower meet established standards. Proper BSA standards for instruction, supervision and safety training are carried out.
5. Serve as a merit badge counselor for Climbing Merit Badge.
6. Coordinate Climb On Safely.
7. Serve as a C.I.T. Mentor.
8. Be an enthusiastic key leader of the entire camp staff – work closely with the Camp Director and other key leaders in providing positive leadership to the staff. Assist the Program Director in planning and implementing staff morale boosters.
9. Attend Area Directors meetings.
10. Responsible for opening and closing inventories of all Tower equipment.
11. Other duties as assigned by the Camp Director.
